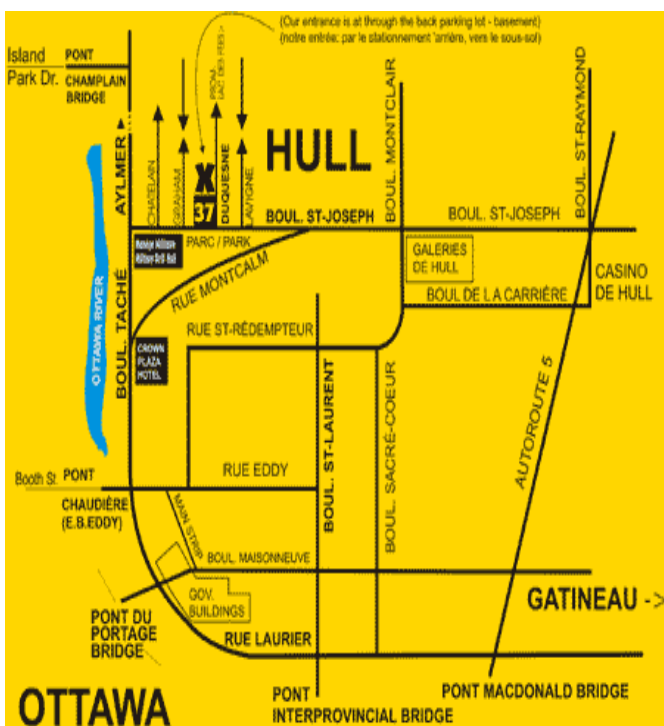

HULL, Quebec... your Summer destination *Natural Beauty...*

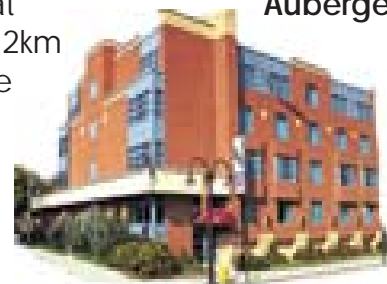
The historic Rideau Canal, constructed in 1832, stretches from Kingston to Ottawa and is complete with campgrounds, accommoda-

Accommodation?

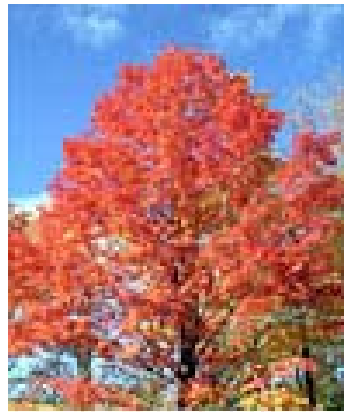
